Accommodation

Off-site residence (Charminster)

Charminster residence is located at a 20 minutes' walk from Summer Centre.
Accommodation is arranged in single en-suite rooms.

Students are supervised by Kings residential wardens and internet access is available throughout the residence.

Under 16's receive a room key only and not a main door fob.

Homestay

Our selected homestays are a bus ride from the centre (usually 25 - 30 minutes). Students make their own way to and from the centre

Accommodation is arranged in standard twin rooms with shared bathroom facilities (single rooms available on request — supplement applies).

All families are carefully selected and inspected by the Kings Accommodation Manager.

Students under 16 are not given a house key.

Meal Plan

Breakfast, lunch and dinner every day. Lunch is a combination of hot lunches and packed lunches.

We can cater for vegetarian and other dietary requirements on special request.

Evening Curfew

Please note that there are curfews in place for all students. Students aged under 16 must return to their host family or residence by 21.30 every evening.

Students aged 16 – 17 must return to their host family or residence by 22.30 every evening.
