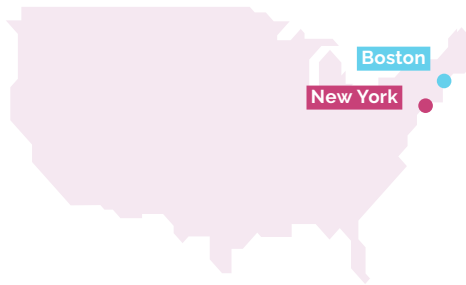
Meal plan

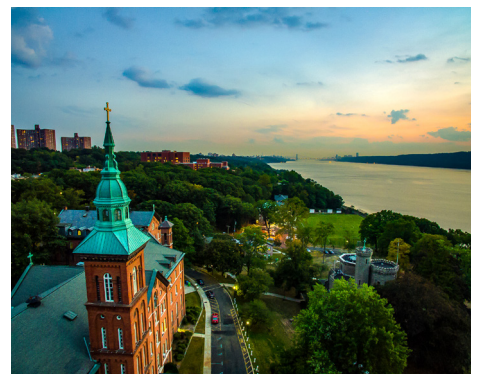
